- ARE YOU STAYING IN TEMPORARY HOUSING?
- DO YOU WANT TO STAY IN YOUR CURRENT SCHOOL?
- ARE YOU HAVING TROUBLE ENROLLING IN SCHOOL OR GETTING THERE?

Help may be available.



1. You have special rights at school if you are:

- Staying temporarily with someone else because you had to leave your home
- Staying in a motel, trailer park, or campground
- Staying outside or in a place that is not meant for sleeping
- Staying in poor housing that does not have utilities such as water, electricity, or heat
- Staying in a shelter or in a car



2. Those rights include:

- Staying in the same school even if you move, and receiving transportation to that school, as long as it's your best interest
- Enrolling in school immediately without the documents schools usually require, and without a parent or guardian
- Receiving free school meals
- Getting help with school supplies and other needs
